Dear Ms. Wiley and Captain Killinger,

I am in receipt of your December 25, 2006 letter petition and the January 8, 2007 email response from Portland Police Bureau Records Manager Captain Randall Killinger. I have had an opportunity to review confidential police report 86-129767. The Police Bureau has claimed exemption of the document as a child abuse report.

The confidentiality of child abuse reports is outlined in ORS 419B.035:

(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of ORS 192.001 to 192.170, 192.210 to 192.505 and 192.610 to 192.990 relating to confidentiality and accessibility for public inspection of public records and public documents, **reports and records compiled under the provisions of ORS 419B.010 to 419B.050 are confidential and are not accessible for public inspection.**


This office is not in a position to order the police bureau to disclose even a redacted police report compiled as part of a child abuse investigation. The intent of the statute is to protect the privacy of the victim. Accordingly, your petition must be denied.

I have included the OJIN print out of the prosecution of Mr. Wiley for Sex Abuse in the first degree. I would say that from a review of our office electronic notes there is no indication Mr. Wiley was not in fact guilty for the crime for which he was convicted.
