FORMER BOOKKEEPER OF K&F COFFEE ROASTERS INDICTED FOR ALLEGED EMBEZZLEMENT

Today, Multnomah County District Attorney Rod Underhill announced a 58-count indictment has been filed against a Hillsboro woman for allegedly stealing approximately \$160,000.

It is alleged that between March 2016 and September 2017, the defendant, Yor Lisa Lor, as the bookkeeper, used her position at K&F Coffee Roasters to write checks to her personal financial accounts for a loss of approximately \$160,000.

The indictment alleges multiple counts of identity theft for forging the names of the two owners of K&F Coffee while writing the checks.

Lor made her first court appearance at the Multnomah County Justice Center on April 12, 2018 at 2 p.m before Multnomah County Circuit Court Judge David F. Rees. Her next court date is scheduled for June 1, 2018.

A copy of the indictment filed in this case can be obtained through the Oregon eCourt Case Information (OECI) system using Case Number 18CR24001.

This case is being investigated by the Portland Police Bureau's White Collar Crimes Unit.

Multnomah County Deputy District Attorney Sean Mazorol is prosecuting this case.
