MULTNOMAH COUNTY GRAND JURY ISSUES NOT TRUE BILL FOLLOWING APRIL 7, 2018 OFFICER INVOLVED SHOOTING

Today, Multnomah County District Attorney Rod Underhill announced that after four days of hearing testimony a Multnomah County grand jury issued a not true bill for all of the law enforcement officers who used lethal force on Saturday April 7, 2018, at 526 Southeast Grand Avenue.

The shooting resulted in the death of 48-year-old John Andrew Elifritz.

A not true bill decision by the grand jury means no criminal prosecution is warranted as a result of the use of deadly force by the involved officers.

In accordance to the District Attorney's Office policy, a request will be made to Multnomah County Presiding Judge Stephen K. Bushong to have the grand jury proceedings transcribed and then subsequently released to the public.
