Secret indictment against Stacy Lee Curtiss unsealed in Multnomah County Circuit Court

Today, Multnomah County District Attorney Rod Underhill announced that a 25-count secret indictment against 33-year-old Stacy Lee Curtiss was unsealed in Multnomah County Circuit Court.

The indictment, which was filed on January 25, 2019, charges Curtiss with 10 counts of encouraging child sexual abuse in the first degree, 14 counts of encouraging child sexual abuse in the second degree and one count of encouraging the sexual assault of an animal.

It is alleged in court documents that between September 2017 and June 2018, the defendant was unlawfully and knowingly in possession of and developed, duplicated and/or disseminated multiple visual recordings of sexually explicit conduct involving a child and disregarded the fact that the images involved child abuse. Furthermore, it is alleged that Curtis unlawfully and knowingly, and for the purpose of satisfying sexual desires, was in possession of a visual recording of a person engaged in sexual conduct with an animal.

During this investigation, law enforcement learned that the defendant was employed as a babysitter in Multnomah County.

On January 30, 2019, the defendant appeared in Multnomah County Circuit Court and was arraigned on the indictment. The next court date is scheduled for March 12, 2019.

At this time, detectives assigned to the Portland Police Bureau's Sex Crimes Unit continue to investigate this matter. Anyone with information on Curtiss is asked to call 503.823.0400.

This remains ongoing investigation and as such, no additional information shall be released by the District Attorney's Office.

A copy of the indictment can be obtained using the Oregon eCourt Information (OECI) system under case number 19CR06087.

This case is being prosecuted by Multnomah County Deputy District Attorney BJ Park.

An indictment is only an accusation of a crime. The defendant is innocent unless and until proven guilty.
