### **Nicholas Hannan pleads guilty to assaulting, killing Diego Tejada-Manzo in Portland, Oregon**

Today, Multnomah County District Attorney Rod Underhill announced that 20-year-old Nicholas Hannan appeared in Multnomah County Circuit Court and pleaded guilty to manslaughter in the first degree with a firearm and assault in the second degree.

As stated on the record during Tuesday's change of plea hearing with Judge Eric J. Bergstrom, the defendant will be sentenced on January 10 at 10:30 a.m. and will receive 15 years in prison.

According to court documents, at approximately 1 a.m. on November 7, 2017, officers assigned to the Portland Police Bureau responded to reports of a disturbance and a shooting near the Vue Apartment complex, located in the 1700 block of Southwest Park Avenue in Portland, Oregon.

Upon arrival, law enforcement located Diego Tejada-Manzo, 21, suffering from a gunshot wound. The Oregon State Medical Examiner's Office determined Mr. Tejada-Manzo died of homicidal violence.

According to information stated on the record during a release hearing in February 2018, the defendant, and others, confronted Mr. Tejada-Manzo outside a sandwich shop. During the altercation, Hannan physically attacked Mr. Tejada-Manzo and fired multiple rounds from a handgun.

Law enforcement determined that David Michael Brown, 27, and potentially two others were with Hannan and participated in the assault of Mr. Tejada-Manzo.

Detectives with the Portland Police Bureau learned that Mr. Tejada-Manzo was armed during the physical altercation and shot back at Hannan. Hannan was struck in the abdomen.

Hannan's co-defendant, Brown, is currently charged with one count of assault in the second degree and assault in the third degree. His next court date is scheduled for December 19, 2018.

Until both of these cases are resolved, no additional information can be released.

Brown is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.

A copy of the photograph of Mr. Tejada-Manzo and his parents, which was displayed in court, is being released to the media with permission.
